Who are we?

The Geriatric Day Hospital is a program that helps adults aged 65 and older to be healthy and independent. The program is funded by the Regional Geriatric Program of Eastern Ontario. There is no charge to attend.

Our goal is to help you be healthy, independent, and safe, so you can stay in your home as long as possible.

We work with you to:

- Promote healthy living
- Achieve or maintain your independence
- Provide exercises for your body and mind
- Encourage social interaction
- Provide support and education
- Link you with community support



Our team of health care professionals works with you, your family doctor, your family members, and/or your caregivers to develop a care plan that suits your needs.

- Physiotherapist (PT)

What do we do?

We offer:

- Individual assessments with our healthcare professionals. We assess memory, how you function in your daily life, including driving, mobility, medication management etc.
- Group: A 7-week program Tuesday and Thursday mornings 9:00 11:30 a.m.
- Caregiver information sessions
- Cognition clinics

How can I get an appointment?

Your doctor, the geriatric assessment outreach team, or any other healthcare professional can refer you to the Geriatric Day Hospital.

Your first visit will be for a 1 ½ hour assessment with the Nurse Practitioner.
